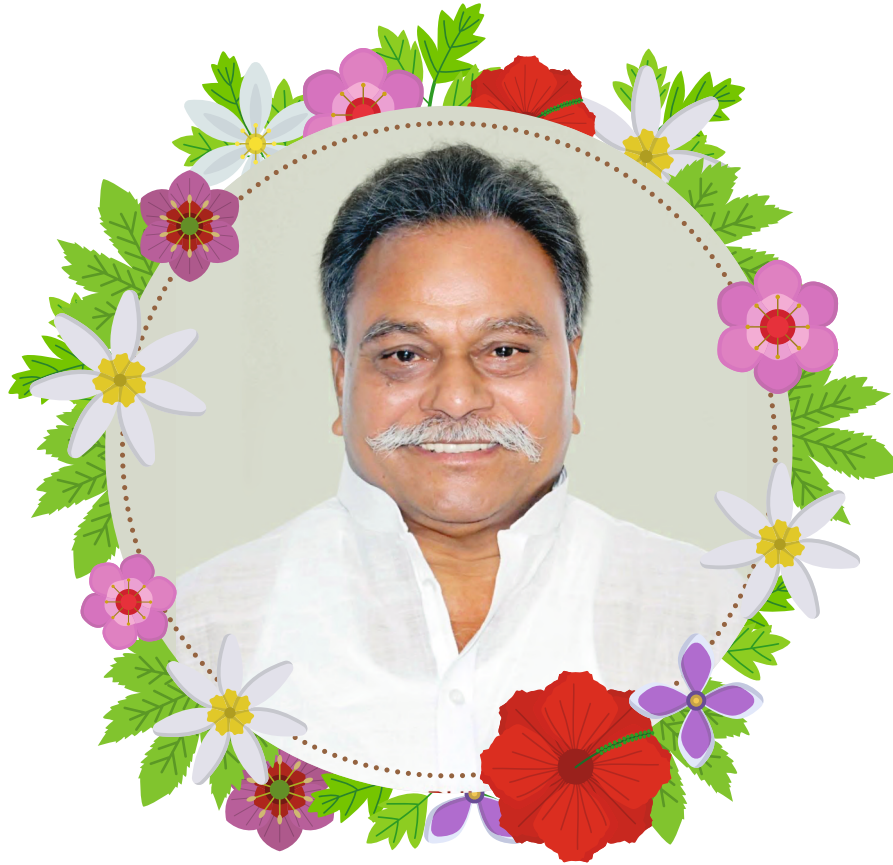

Skilling and Livelihood

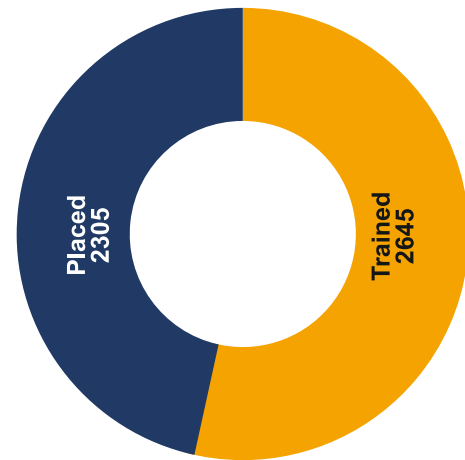

ANUPRERANA

Introduced career counseling sessions in Government Schools across Kadapa District, impacted 18,500 students from 265 Government High Schools in 38 Mandals, and later expanding our efforts in 2022 to reach 25,677 students across 30 mandals in Warangal, Mulugu, and Hanumakonda districts to offer improved career guidance tailored to their skills and job expectations.

VIDVATTA

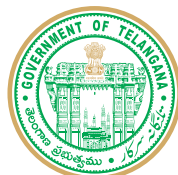
Originating from a financially disadvantaged background, the foundation's generous founder has always been committed to providing substantial donations to support the education of underprivileged children in Proddatur. In alignment with his vision, an annual allocation of scholarships are bestowed upon 500 deserving students on 22nd March every year, which has impacted a cumulative total of 6250 recipients to date.

Aarogyam

The organization actively promotes health and well-being in diverse regions through its Aarogyam initiative. Operating from KC Pullaiah Healthcare Centers situated in Autonagar, Karimnagar, and Proddatur, the foundation focuses on meeting the basic healthcare needs of the underprivileged through consistent medical camps, blood donation drives, TB and HIV checkups, and by offering nutritional support to PLHIV (People Living with HIV) and CLHIV (Children Living with HIV).

Clinic in Hyderabad

Assisting the Truck drivers about HIV/AIDS & providing required medicine and support Reaching out to approximately 50,000

Nutrition Support to Childrens

For the past two years, we have been providing nutritional support to 250 children living with HIV/AIDS among 2300 childrens in twin cities, in addition to assisting them with regular medical checkups.

Other Medical Camps

We are conducting regular medical and blood donation camps, along with offering free eye checkups to the community in rural areas

Clinic in Karimnagar

Providing HIV/AIDS assistance and necessary medication, as well as offering support to truck drivers, aiming to reach approximately 25,000 individuals.

Clinic in Proddatur

Through this clinic, we are extending free checkups and medication to economically poor individuals, with the goal of reaching out to 500 people every month.

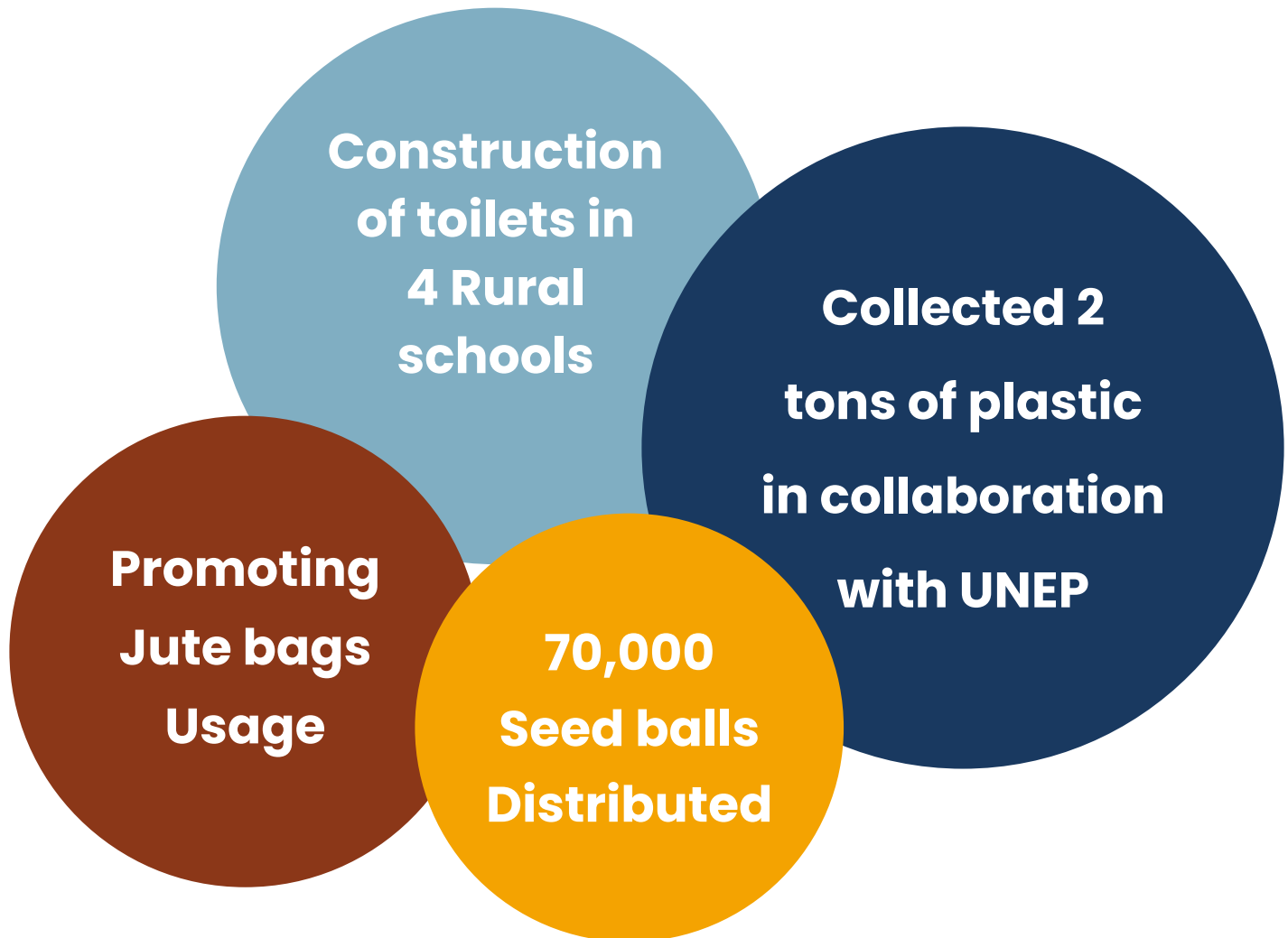

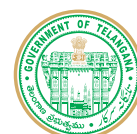


Environment

Our Foundation initiated the Vanam-Manam environment protection activity, promoting concepts like Seed balls and jute Bags at various project sites and locations, distributing 70,000 Seed balls as part of the initiative. Additionally, we engage the youth in clean and green programs, construct toilets for government schools, participate in highway plantations for the SWACCH BHARAT Mission, and organize environmental awareness competitions for students. Recently partnered with UNEP to launch a campaign called "I am a Salvager" focused on the theme Beat Plastic Pollution.

Social Inclusion

The foundation functions within the Social Inclusion sector, focusing on diverse welfare initiatives for the vulnerable communities (LGBTQ, Sex Workers, PLHIV, CLHIV etc)

During the Covid-19 Pandemic, KC Pullaiah Foundation collaborated with Tech Mahindra Foundation to distribute 4500 dry ration kits to vulnerable communities. Among these, 2000 kits were allocated to the transgender community in Hyderabad, Telangana, while 2500 kits were provided to sex workers, transgender individuals, and disabled communities in Andhra Pradesh. Additionally, advocacy meetings were held with policy stakeholders, focusing on establishing partnerships with various organizations and community-based groups addressing the crisis's challenges.

Helping Hands Activities

The foundation collaborates with various organizations to extend its activities for the impact of the needy public through concerted programs, including youth empowerment with Yuvathirang and Kalam Center. We provide educational support to blind school children through online classes, meets individual needs of orphanages and old age homes with essentials like kitchen equipment, class benches, school bags, books, and blankets. The foundation also extends support to music, culture, and arts organizations, offers higher education support to bright students from economically disadvantaged families, financially supports youth interested in sports, and conducts food distribution drives for the poor during times like the Covid pandemic impacted more than 1,00,000 people.
